The legal bases for processing personal data is vital interests of data subject or another natural person (GDPR Art.6) to track the spreading of the epidemic. This information will be stored for 7 days on the vessel and destroyed by the chief officer. The data will not be transferred to any third party, only for authorities in case needed.

- Seek immediate medical attention if you have serious symptoms. Always call before visiting your doctor or health facility.
- People with mild symptoms who are otherwise healthy should manage their symptoms at home. On average it takes 5–6 days from when someone is infected with the virus for symptoms to show, however it can take up to 14 days.
